- **Efficiency with integrity:** More efficient assessment processes that are rigorous, fair, and timely and reflect northern environmental, social, cultural, and economic realities
- **Clarity and predictability:** Better alignment of information requirements and processes will improve certainty for proponents, governments, Indigenous organizations, and the public.
- **Indigenous Knowledge at the centre:** Coordination strengthens the integration of Indigenous Knowledge and regional context into assessment and decision making.
- **Strong partnerships, better outcomes:** Shared approaches reduce administrative burden while supporting high-quality assessments.



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
